Permanent and Adjunct Faculty Positions Liberal Arts Programme

The Indus Valley School of Art and Architecture is a premier institution of higher education in Karachi, Pakistan and offers degree programmes in the fields of art, design, and architecture. All IVS undergraduate students also take courses in the humanities and social sciences, which are offered by the Liberal Arts Programme. We are currently accepting applications for both permanent and adjunct faculty positions. We seek highly motivated and qualified individuals who are able to teach in an interdisciplinary framework and have a proven track record of research and teaching.

Permanent faculty positions

Main responsibilities will include teaching core and elective courses in the undergraduate Liberal Arts Programme, advising on curriculum and student research across the school's creative and professional programmes, maintaining an active research and publication schedule, and contributing actively to other intellectual and administrative activities of the institution as required.

Adjunct faculty positions

The Programme will consider applicants for a wide variety of courses in the humanities and social sciences. We are, however, especially interested in applicants for the following two core courses:

Visual and Material Cultures

Students enroll in this two-course sequence in their first and second years at IVS. Applicants with advanced degrees in art history, visual studies, media and film studies, or architecture are encouraged to apply. Practicing artists, designers, and architects who may not have an advanced degree but are able to demonstrate commitment to research as well as an interest in history and critical theory will also be considered.

Research Methods

This course introduces upper-level students to the main research methods and disciplinary approaches used to study visual culture and cultural production. We are looking for applicants who have experience with conducting research in the humanities and social sciences, particularly those with a background in visual and cultural studies, urban studies, media and film studies, anthropology, or sociology.

Eligibility

Applicants must hold a Master's or PhD degree in a relevant field and minimum three years' (post-degree) experience working in an academic institution.

- A detailed CV, including the names of three professional/academic referees

You are also strongly encouraged to submit a sample syllabus (this could be for a course you've already taught or one you propose to teach at IVS) and past teaching evaluations.
