The Department of Architecture offers a five year-long Bachelor of Architecture degree programme that teaches students to approach architectural design holistically, within specific contextual conditions. The programme develops students' skills for building functionality, materials and methods of construction, structural systems, building services and digital technology. It also encourages a research-driven, context-sensitive, user-centric and energy-conscious approach to the design of buildings and their surroundings.

Applications for permanent faculty positions at all levels (Lecturer, Associate Professor, and Professor) will be considered.

Core Responsibilities:

- 1. Architecture faculty teach, organize and manage the development of studio courses in the department.
- 2. Faculty are expected to contribute actively to curriculum development in the department and to institutional activities, as well as actively pursuing opportunities for research, publication and scholarly/creative practice.

Qualifications:

Candidates are expected to have a Master's degree in Architecture or relevant field from a HEC-recognized institution and must be registered, paid members of PCATP. Required Skills:

- 1. A student-centric and problem-solving approach
- 2. Ability to engage in interdisciplinary and cross-disciplinary collaborations
- 3. Up-to-date knowledge of the discipline, and of relevant technologies and software
- 4. Excellent written and verbal communication skills

- A cover letter with a detailed CV, including a list of 3 professional references
- Statement of teaching philosophy
- Digital portfolio of works and/or sample publications.
